Cost of attendance (COA) is defined as the estimated cost to attend a college or university for one academic year, and it establishes a student's maximum financial aid eligibility. An estimate of the average costs of room and board is included in cost of attendance. At UT Austin, the cost of room and board represents the average cost of living in the Austin area while in attendance. Room and board costs assume one roommate.

The budgeted costs of room and board for the 2018-2019 academic year (**9 months**) are \$10,804 for undergraduate students and \$12,930 for graduate students. Summer term room and board costs are calculated separately.

To request a reevaluation of your budgeted room and board expenses, submit this signed and completed form with a copy of your lease agreement or housing contract. You may provide additional details about your specific living circumstances by attaching a written statement to this form.

Please note that any additional awards will be **loans only**. It is possible that you may have already received the maximum Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loan amounts for the current year. Typically, dependent and graduate students will be awarded a PLUS Loan. Undergraduate independent students may need to apply for an alternative loan.
